AFTER THE MONARCHY ENDED IN 1918, THE GERMAN PEOPLE NO LONGER HAD ANY FORM OF GOVERNMENT THEY TRUSTED OR BELIEVED IN.





THEY WANTED TO FIND SOME KIND OF HOPE FOR THE FUTURE. WHO WOULD SAVE THEM?



THIS VACUUM OF CONFIDENCE IN THEMSELVES AND THEIR GOVERNMENT MADE ROOM FOR SOME VERY EXTREME IDEAS. THERE WAS A YOUNG MAN, HIMSELF A VETERAN OF THE GREAT WAR, WHO WAS READY TO GRAB THE REINS OF POWER WHILE THE GREAT GERMAN HORSE WAS WITHOUT A RIDER.



THE NAZIS STIRRED UP POPULAR SUPPORT FOR AN UPRISING AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT LEADERS. HITLER GAVE FIERY SPEECHES OF HATRED AGAINST THE GERMAN AUTHORITIES WHO HAD "STABBED GERMANY IN THE BACK." DURING THIS TIME A SPECIAL GROUP OF PERSONAL ENFORCERS CALLED "THE SA" OR "STORM TROOPERS" FORMED AROUND HITLER TO PROTECT HIS NAZI MOVEMENT AND RALLIES.

(LATER SHORTENED INTO THE

WORD "NAZI"). THESE MEN

WERE VERY ANGRY WITH

THE CURRENT GERMAN GOVERNMENT, COMPOSED OF THE SAME DIPLOMATS WHO HAD AGREED TO SIGN THE HUMILIATING TREATY

November 1923 Hitler and his proxy army of

storm troopers attempted to grab control of the government through brute force—a coup or, in German, a "Putsch."

THE ATTEMPTED
HIJACKING WAS ILL CONCEIVED
AND QUICKLY THWARTED.
HITLER, AS THE LEADER,
WAS SWIFTLY ARRESTED
FOR INSURRECTION. BUT
HE SOMEHOW TURNED
THIS DEFEAT INTO A
TRIUMPH. HIS 1924 TRIAL
BECAME A SENSATION,
GALVANIZING POPULAR
SUPPORT FOR HIS CAUSE.





WHILE INCARCERATED, HE WROTE A BOOK ABOUT HIS LIFE AND RADICAL IDEAS CALLED "MEIN KAMPF" ("MY STRUGGLE"), WHICH WAS PUBLISHED IN 1925.

THOUGH SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR TREASON, HITLER ONLY SERVED SIX MONTHS! HIS BOOK WAS HARDLY A BESTSELLER WHEN PUBLISHED, BUT IT LAID THE GROUNDWORK FOR WHAT WOULD BE HITLER'S LIFE PURSUIT:



A TOTAL GERMAN CONQUEST OF EUROPE AND THE ERADICATION OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE!

He wrote, "I had at last come to the conclusion that the Jew was no German."* Ever since his days in the trenches during the Great War, Hitler had been vocal about his distrust of the Jewish people. But he went beyond mere hatred. Hitler made a personal vow to destroy every Jew in the country. He believed that Germany would never rise again until the "poisoners are exterminated."* Playing on the nation's Christianity, Hitler didn't frame this struggle as political ... but spiritual! "The personification of the Devil as the symbol of all evil assumes the living shape of the Jew."*
